## Stanford Brent

(Ingber Gallery, 415 West Broadway, near Spring Street): Stanford Brent is a young American painter who has moved from enigmatic, lopsided glimpses of architecture to an empyrean of his own devising — a series of huge skies in which clouds form and reform, often in color combinations that challenge nature. Though not always, as yet, completely resolved, they have a vein of tranced poetry that will make it worthwhile to keep after him. (Through July 19.)
